the substance, by reason of its packaging, is such that special packaging is not required to protect children from serious personal injury or serious illness resulting from handling, using, or ingesting the substance, or

(b) Special packaging is not technically feasible, practicable, or appropriate for the subject substance, or

(c) Special packaging is incompatible with the particular substance.

**§ 1702.18 Denying petitions.**

Where the Commission determines that reasonable grounds for an exemption are not presented by the petition,

the petition shall be denied, and the petitioner notified in writing of the denial, including a brief statement of the reasons therefor.

**§ 1702.19 Effect of filing petition.**

The filing of a petition for exemption under this part 1702 shall not have the effect of staying the regulation from which the exemption is sought. Therefore, substances subject to special packaging standards shall be considered in violation of the law unless packaged in special packaging during the Commission's consideration of a petition.
